The tournament is held each year to celebrate the life and memories of Capt. Johnny Uhr, who was well-known in the sportfishing community around the world and died of cancer in 2010.

2<sup>nd</sup> Place Overall went to "Uno Mas" releasing 1 blue marlin and 2 sailfish giving them a total of 700 points.

They also took home the 2<sup>nd</sup> Place dolphin award.
